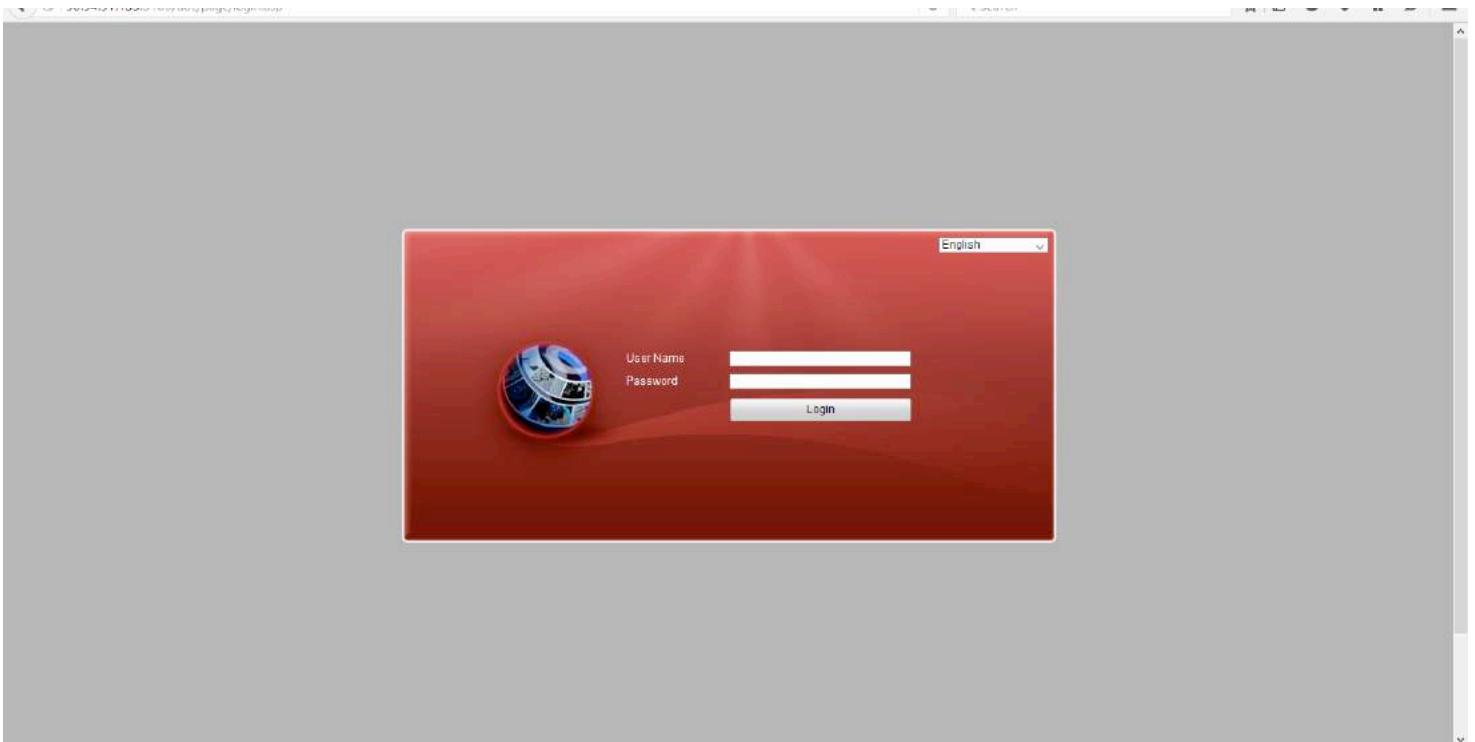


VIEW YOUR SECURITY CAMERAS IN MAC.

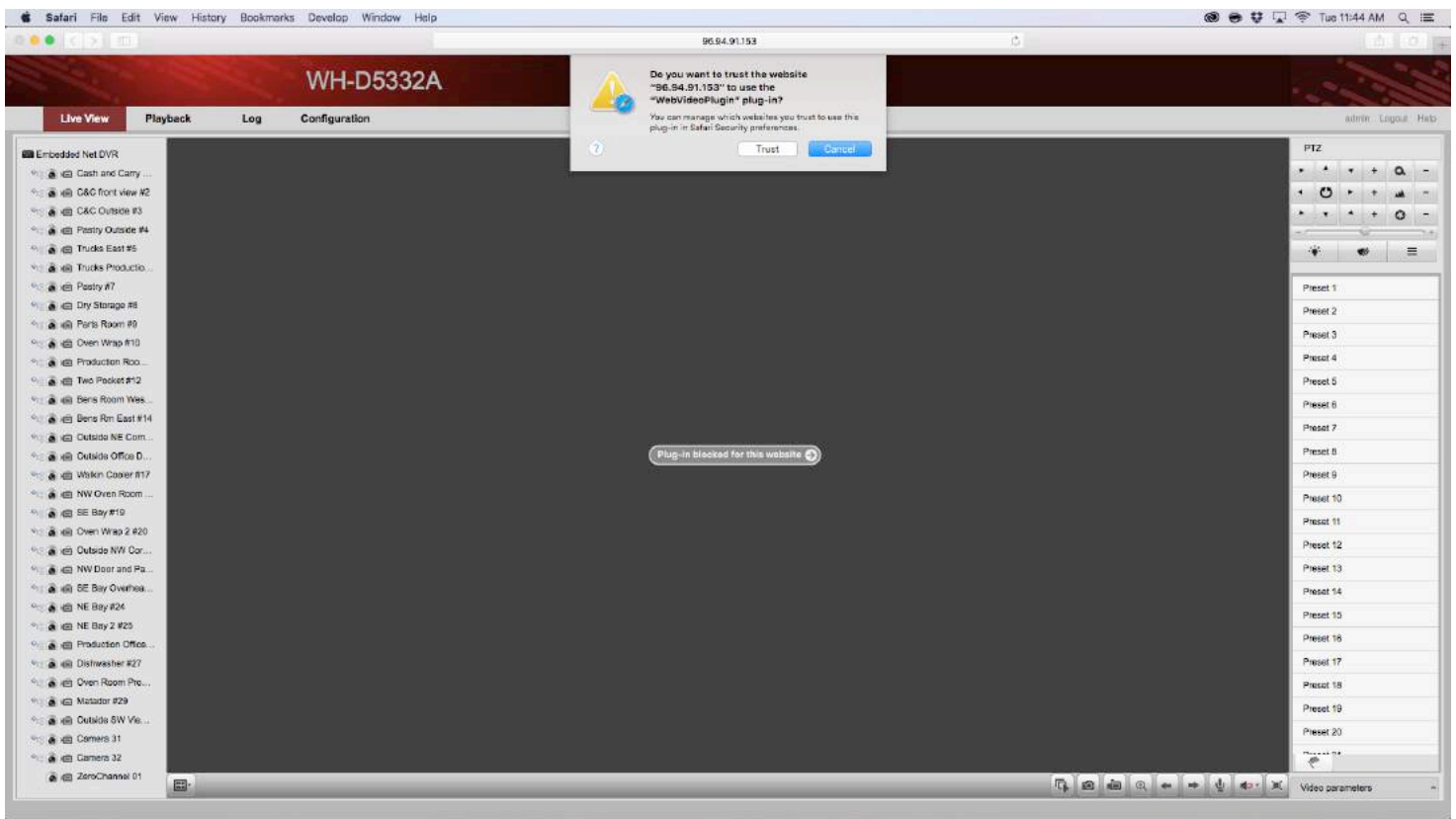
Follow these steps if you want to view your Security Cameras from the browser in Mac.

RED TECHNOLOGY

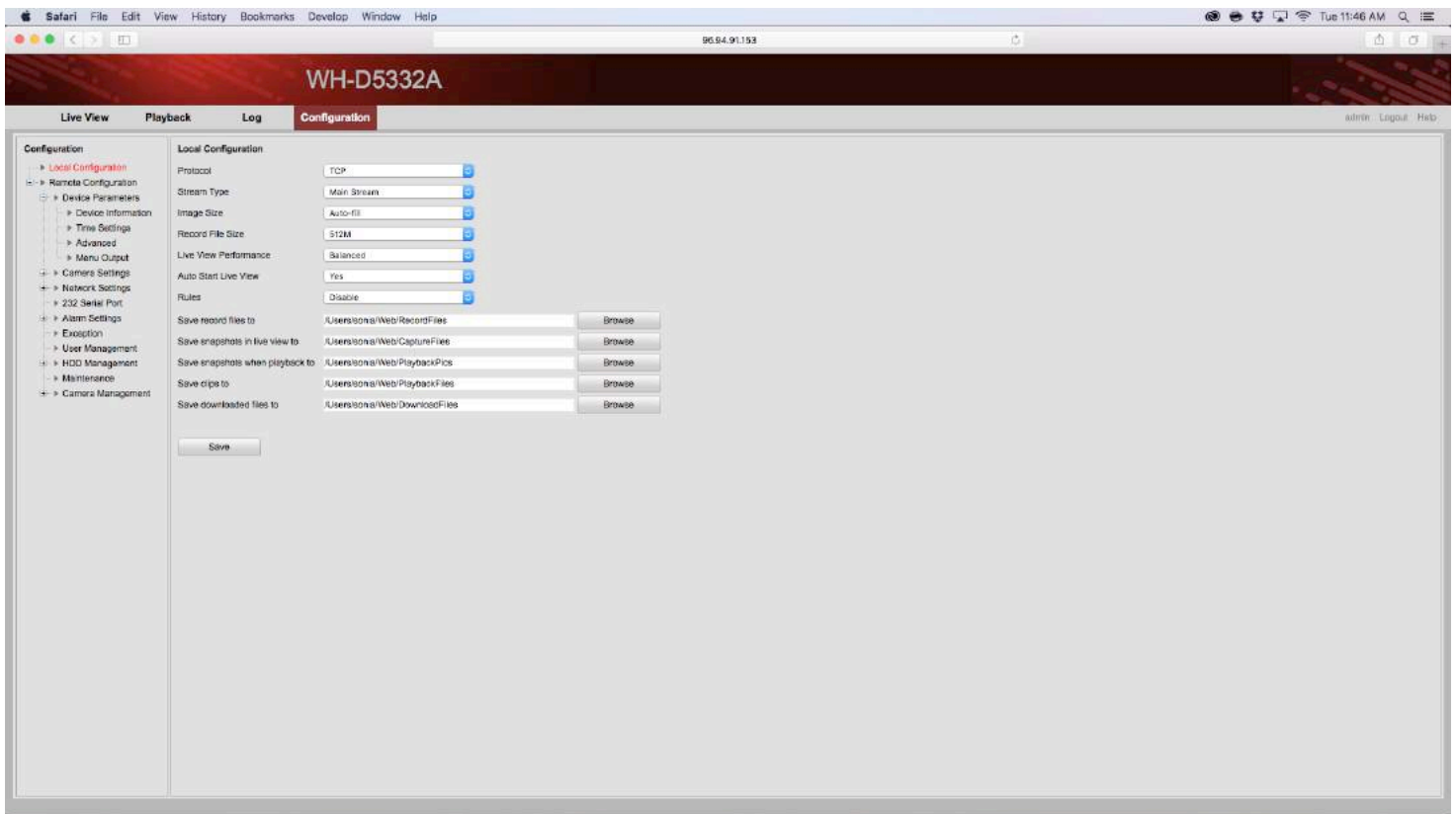
1. Enter to your browser. It will only work on: Safari, Firefox or Internet Explorer.
2. In address bar type your IP address and HTTP port information and hit enter.
3. Put the Username and Password given by your tech team.



- Click in trust.

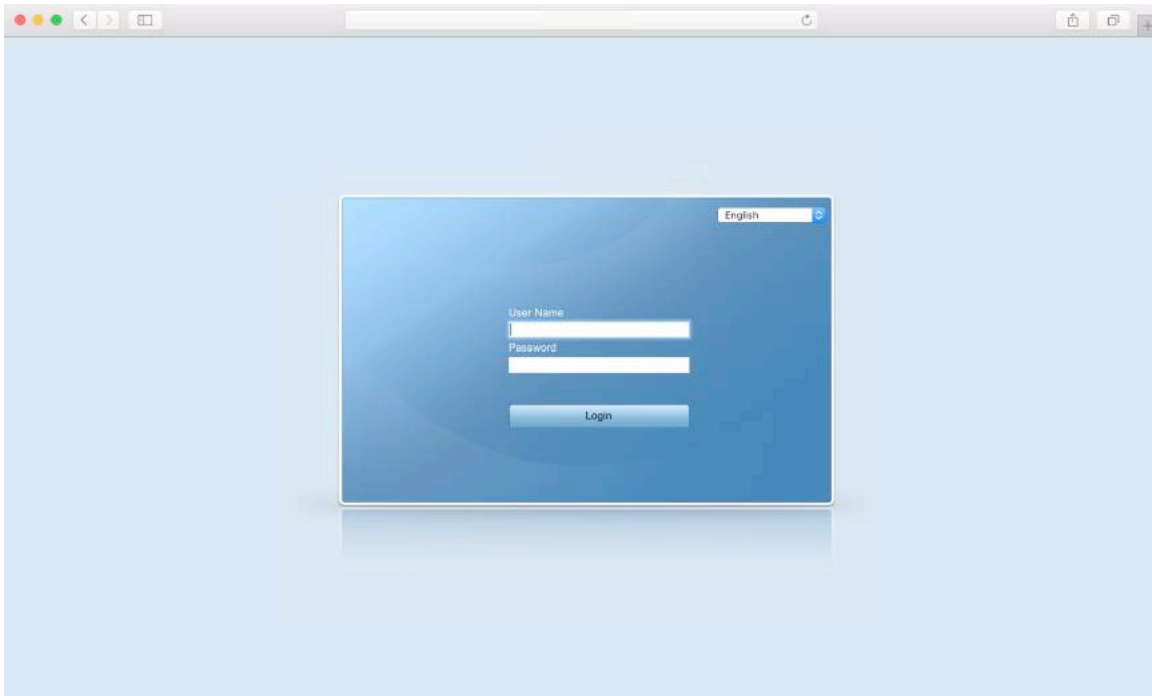


- Click in configuration, and click in Local Configuration.
- Change Auto Start Live view to Yes.

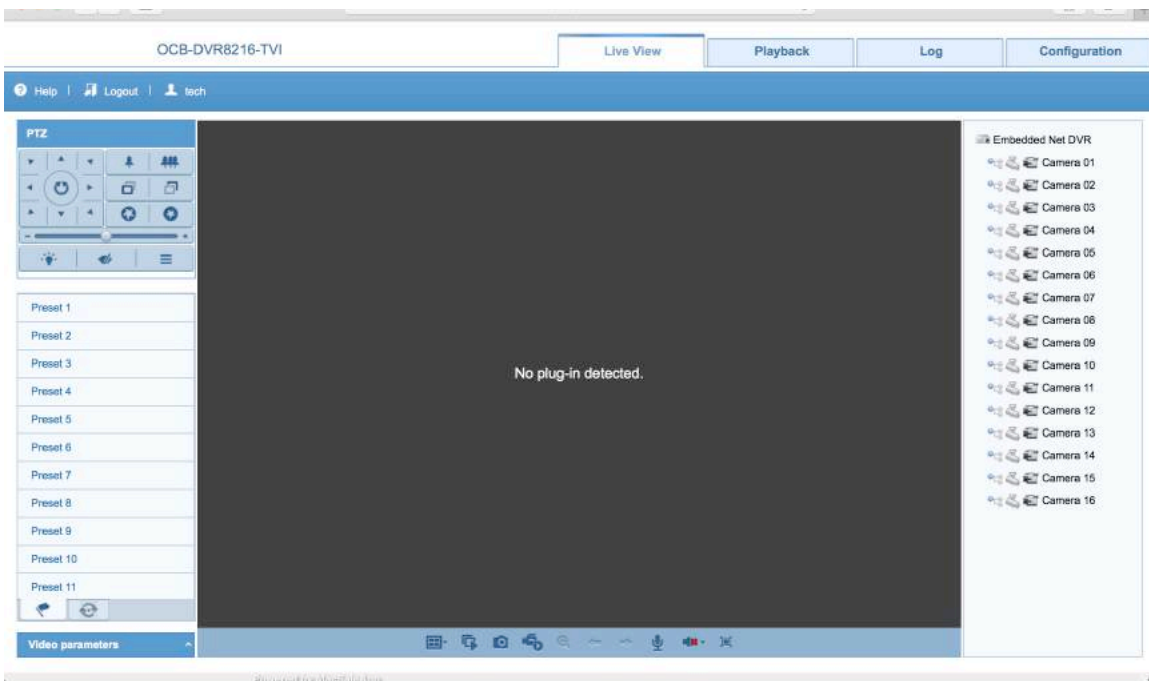


BLUE TECHNOLOGY

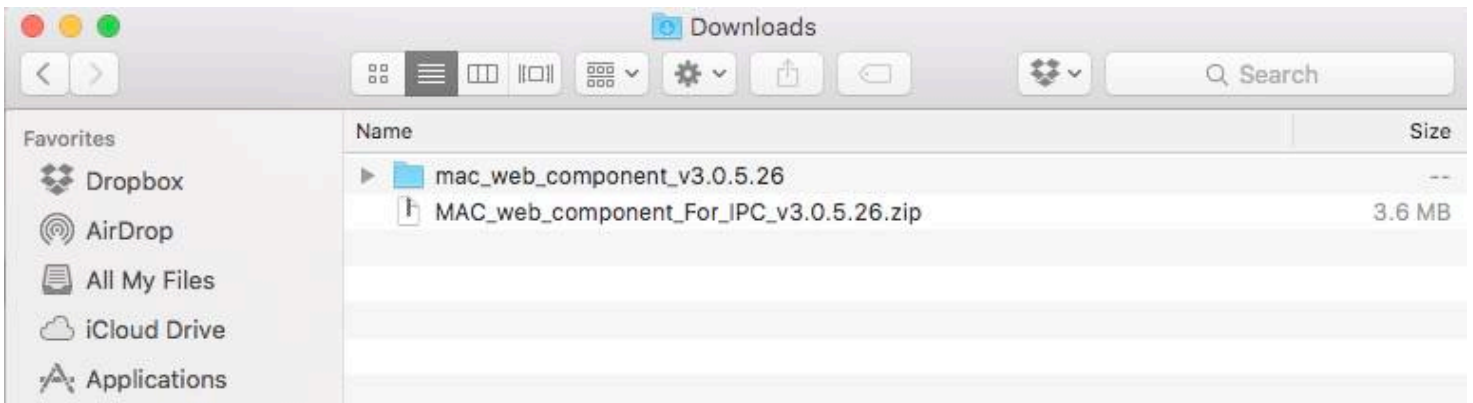
- Put the Username and Password given by your tech team.



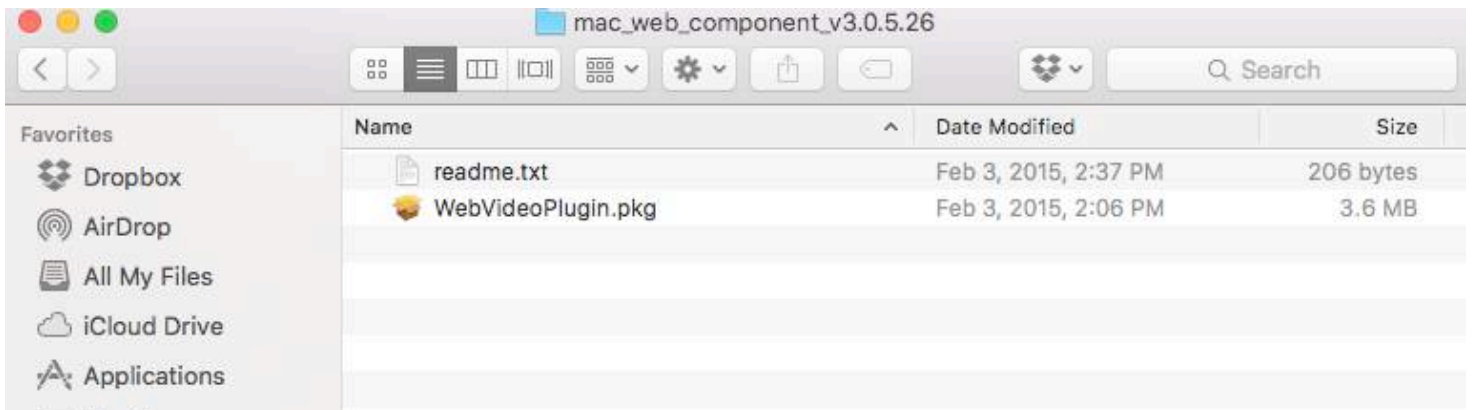
- If the “No Plug-in detected” text appears, you’ll need to install it. This only appears the first time.
- The Plug-in will be given by your tech team or you can follow this link: http://overseas.hikvision.com/us/Tools_82.html then choose “MAC Web Component For IP Cameras v3.0.5.26” and download it.



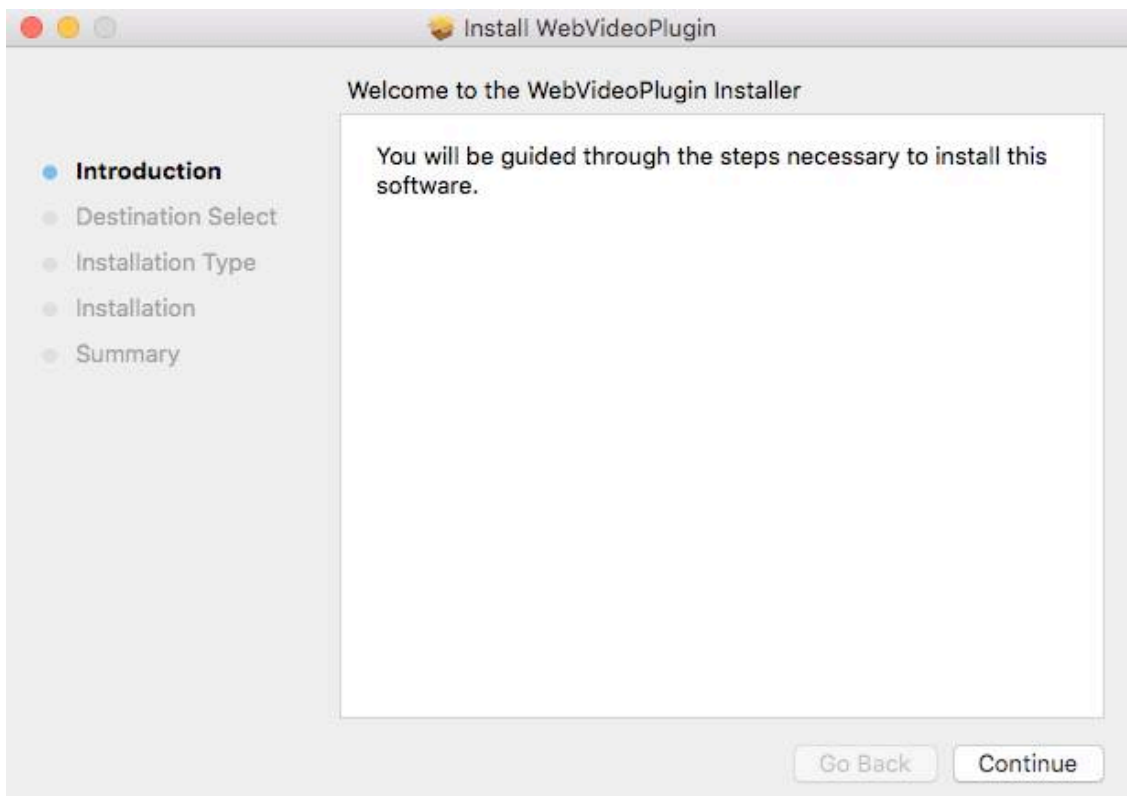
- Double click to unzip the plugin.



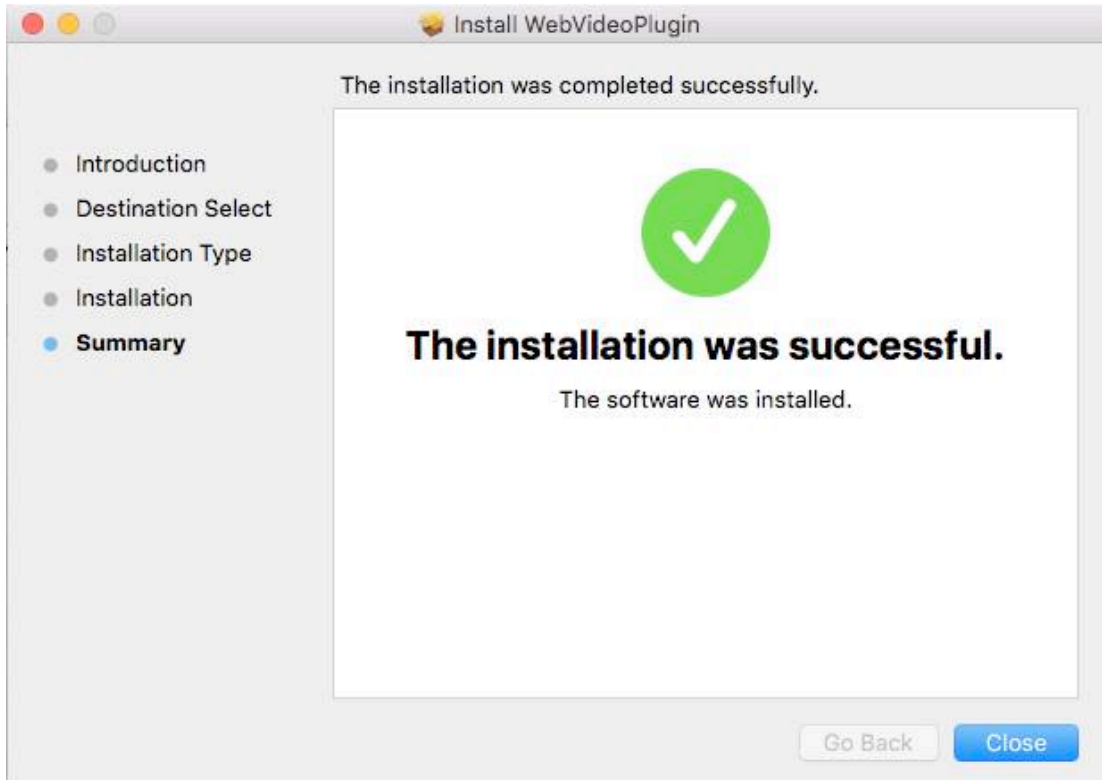
- Double click in the .pkg file.



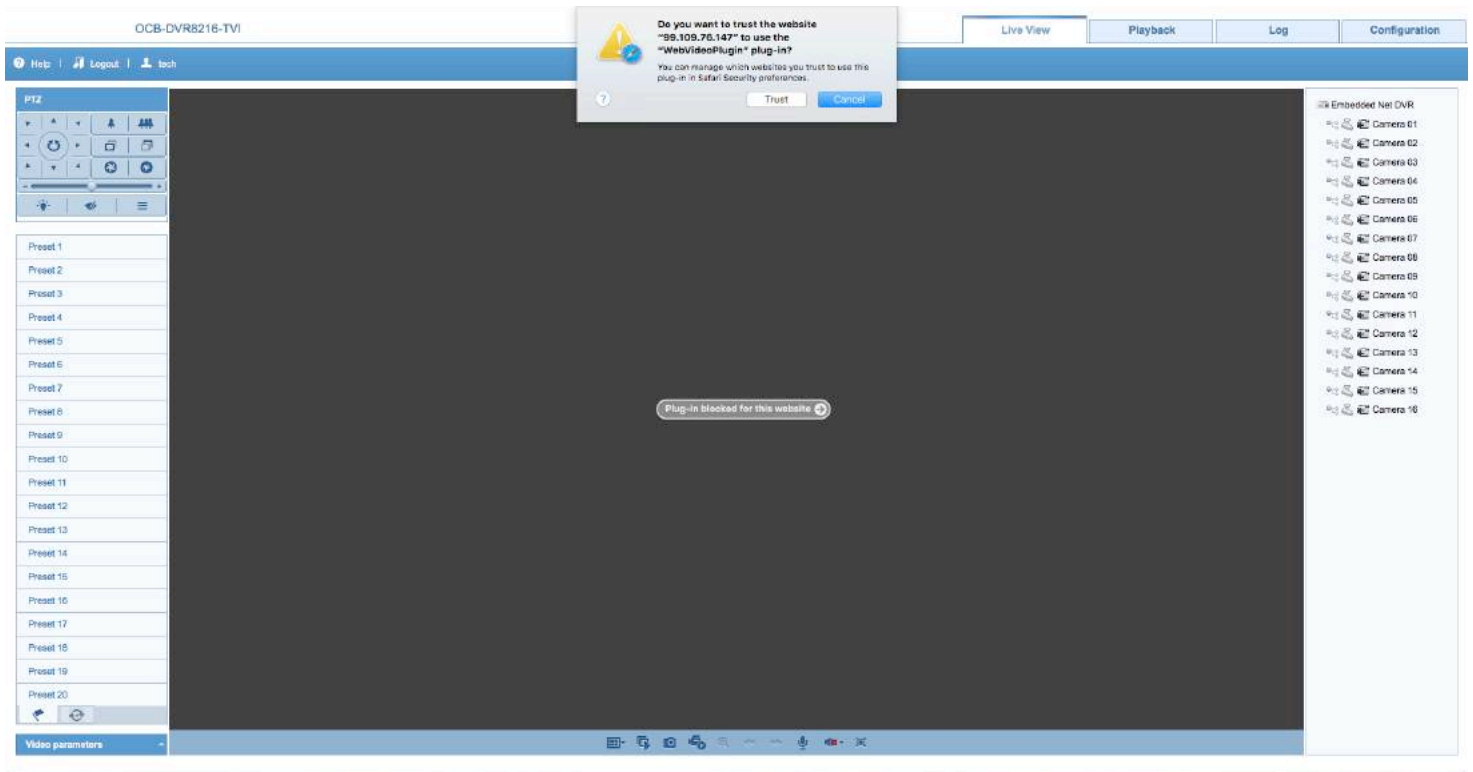
- Click continue. Continue Again. Install.



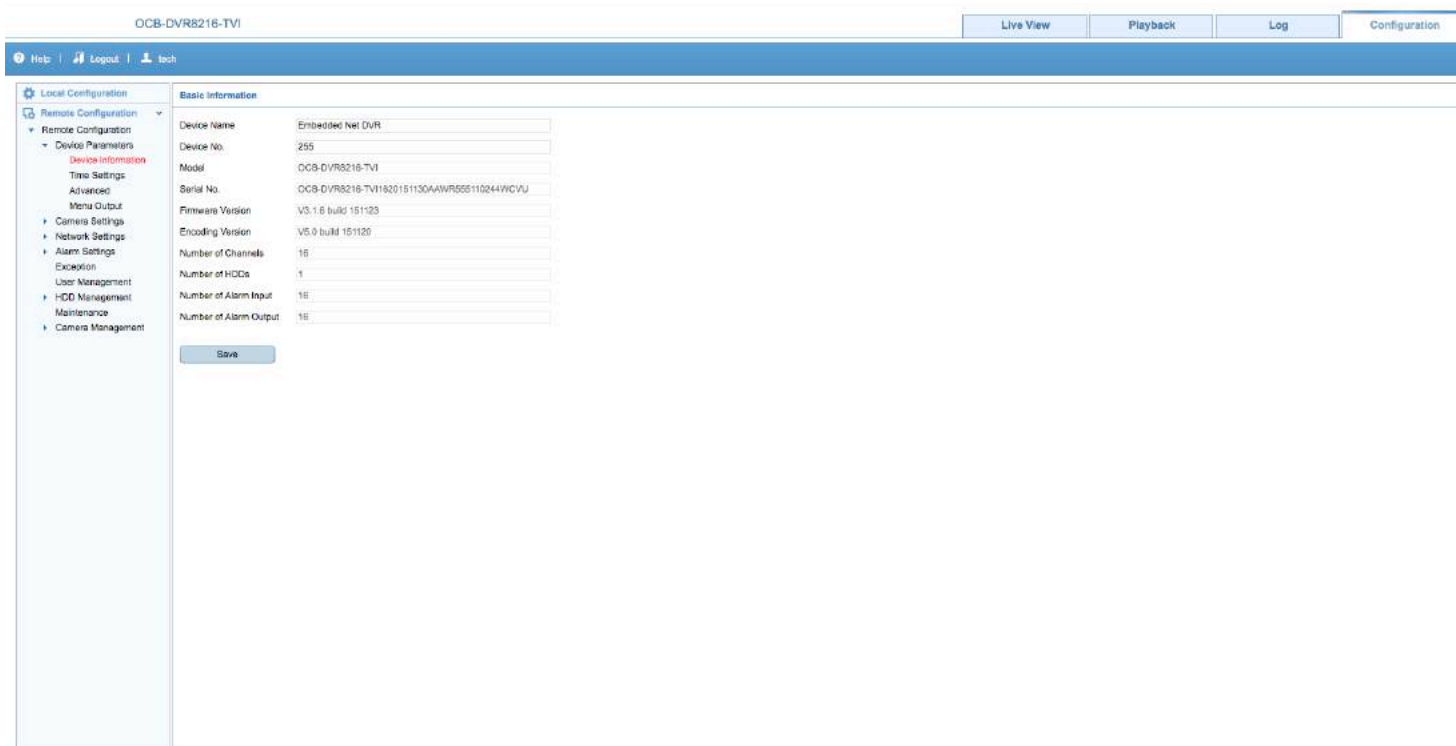
- And your done installing the plug-in.
- Now close safari and open it again.



- Go to the app, (follow step 1, 2 and 3) and click in trust. If the pop up doesn't appear, click in Plug-in blocked for this website to unlock it.



- Click in Configuration. Then Click in Local Configuration.



- In “Auto Start Live View” click in Yes.
- Save.
