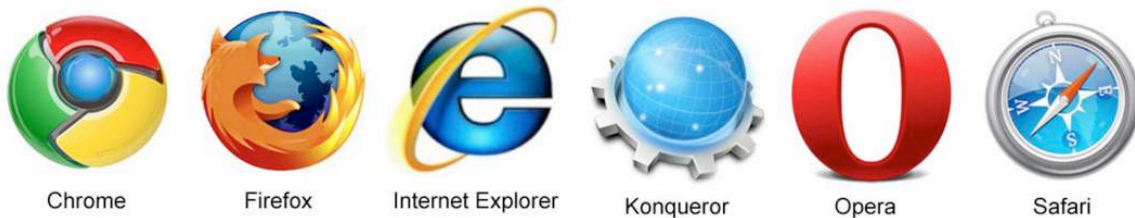


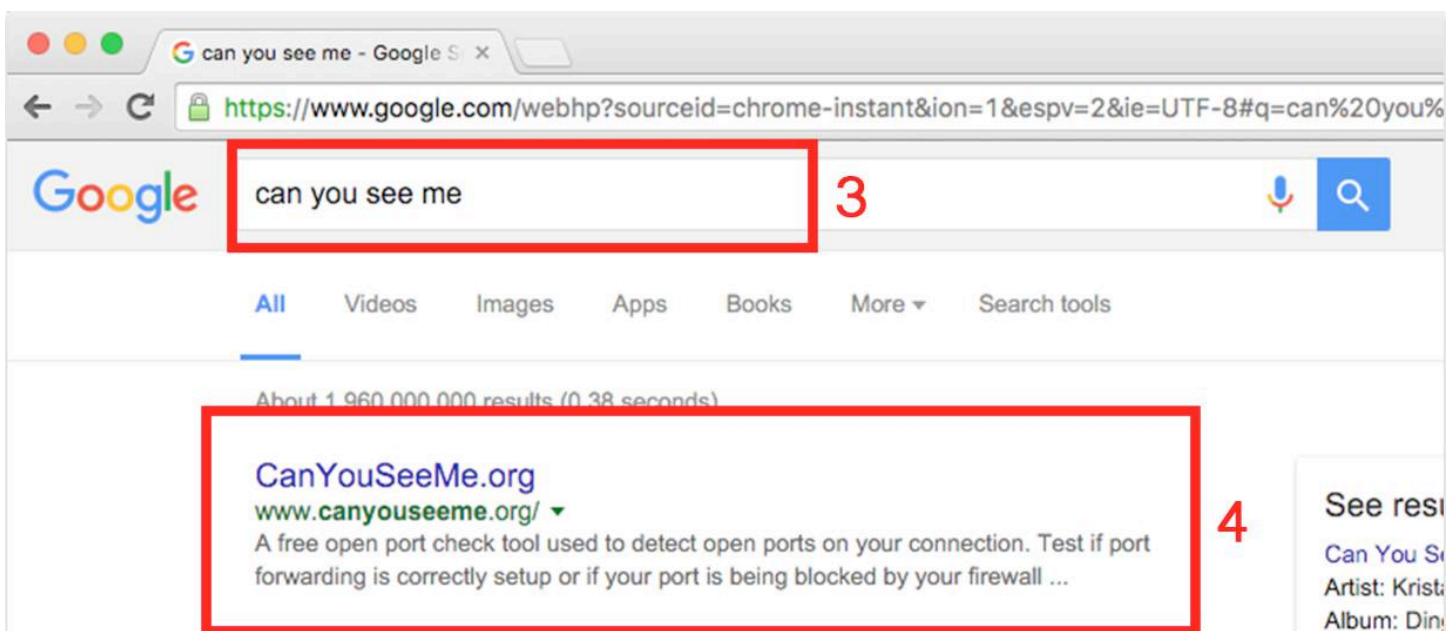
WHAT'S MY IP ADDRESS?

Follow these steps if you want to know your IP Address.

1. First open your browser at your DVR location.



2. Enter to www.google.com
3. Type in google: Can you see me.
4. Enter to www.canyouseeme.org



5. You'll find your IP Address in that website.
